

**AIRPORT CONCESSIONS**  
**DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM**

**POLICY STATEMENT AND OBJECTIVES**

**Section 23.1, 23.23**

**Objectives/Policy Statement**

The Savannah Airport Commission (“the Commission”) has established an Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) program in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 23. The Commission is a primary airport and has received federal funds authorized for airport development after January 1988 (authorized under Title 49 of the United States Code). The Commission has signed airport grant assurances that it will comply with 49 CFR Part 23.

It is the policy of the Savannah Airport Commission to ensure that ACDBEs as defined in Part 23 have an equal opportunity to receive and participate in concession opportunities. It is also policy:


1. To ensure non-discrimination in the award and administration of opportunities for concessions.
2. To create a level playing field on which ACDBEs can compete fairly for concessionaire opportunities;
3. To ensure that the ACDBE Program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law.
4. To ensure that only firms which fully meet the 49 CFR Part 23 eligibility standards are permitted to participate as ACDBEs.
5. To help remove barriers to the participation of ACDBEs in opportunities for concessions at the Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport.



Implementation of the ACDBE Program is accorded the same priority as compliance with all other legal obligations incurred by the Commission in its financial assistance agreements with the Federal Aviation Administration.

**DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM**

**POLICY STATEMENT & OBJECTIVES**

**Section 26.1, 26.23 Objectives/Policy Statement**

The Savannah Airport Commission has established a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 26. The Savannah Airport Commission has received Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation, and as a condition of receiving this assistance, the Savannah Airport Commission has signed an assurance that it will comply with 49 CFR Part 26.

It is the policy of the Savannah Airport Commission to ensure that DBEs as defined in Part 26, have an equal opportunity to receive and participate in DOT-assisted contracts. It is also our policy:


1. To ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of DOT-assisted contracts;
2. To create a level playing field on which DBEs can compete fairly for DOT-assisted contracts;
3. To ensure that the DBE Program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law;
4. To ensure that only firms that fully meet 49 CFR Part 26 eligibility standards are permitted to participate as DBEs;
5. To help remove barriers to the participation of DBEs in DOT-assisted contracts;


